The following activities have been organised for 2024:

POSTGRADUATE COURSES

Postgraduate degrees with the University of Malaga. UMA

 Completion of the 5th Master's Degree in Interdisciplinary Continuing Education in Palliative Care:

Blended learning, 10 students enrolled (7 women and 3 men) (4 doctors, 3 nurses, 1 social worker, 2 psychologists).

CONFERENCES

• I CONFERENCE ON MAGISTRAL FORMULATION:

Aimed at: Doctors, pharmacists and nurses interested in the use of magistral formulations in complex and advanced chronic patients.

Four scientific meetings, two round tables, two workshops and a series of training sessions were held. The conclusions of the conference were presented during the closing ceremony.

TRAINING FOR RESIDENTIAL CARE HOMES / SOCIO-HEALTHCARE

- Project funded by the Malaga Provincial Council: 'Addressing palliative care needs in residential care homes following the COVID-19 pandemic' in four residential care homes in municipalities in the province of Malaga:
 - o Santa Ana Residential Care Home (Álora)
 - o Glorieta de San José Residential Care Home (Arriate)
 - o El Buifarán Care Home (Casarabonela)
 - o Cuevas de San Marcos Municipal Care Home

These consisted of an online training course on end-of-life care and palliative care, as well as an online consulting service for professionals and a workshop on digital skills for residents.

Professional profile: Doctors, nurses, physiotherapists, psychologists, social workers, occupational therapists and nursing assistants.

It took place from March to July 2024.

Total number of professionals trained: 43 enrolled (41 women and 2 men)

Total number of residents who attended the digital skills workshop: 9 enrolled (7 women and 2 men)

• Blended learning course: Diploma in Palliative Care at RESIDENCIA SENIOR DE TORRE DEL MAR.

Blended learning course on end-of-life care for professionals at the Residencia Senior Torre del Mar. Aimed at doctors, nurses, psychologists, social workers and other professionals. The course ran from 17 July to 2 October. 122 hours online and 8 hours in person divided into 2 sessions (17 July and 2 October)

TOTAL: 10 enrolled (9 women and 1 man), only 9 completed the course (8 women and 1 man).

• Workshop on COMMUNICATION AND DECISION-MAKING AT THE END OF LIFE.

End-of-life workshop for professionals at the Torre del Mar Senior Residence. Aimed at doctors, nurses, psychologists, social workers, and other professionals. Two 5-hour in-person sessions. Sessions on 12 and 17 December.

12 December: 11 attendees (10 women, 1 man). 17 December: 7 attendees (5 women and 2 men).

• TRAINING ACTIVITIES AIMED AT OBTAINING THE CERTIFICATE OF PROFESSIONALISM IN SOCIAL AND HEALTH CARE FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES AND/OR IN SITUATIONS OF DEPENDENCY AT HOME AND IN SOCIAL INSTITUTIONS

Blended learning, aimed at unemployed people who are particularly vulnerable. Subsidised by the Ministry of Education and Vocational Training and carried out in collaboration with the Juan Cruzado Vertice Salud Foundation.

It began on 7 October 2024 and will end in 2025.

During the 2024 quarter, face-to-face training activities were carried out.

41 students completed the course (37 women and 4 men).
